Applications for the position of **CAMP COUNSELOR** are being sought from current music majors, as well as from music teachers. Graduate and undergraduate music majors and teachers are most welcome to apply. On occasion, we do consider hiring non-music majors, but considerable experience in music is essential. Those interested in applying for a position as Private Lesson Teacher, Musicianship Class Teacher or Ensemble Conductor may also apply using the appropriate form. **The application deadline is April 15th.**

SUMMER MUSIC CAMP at UNCG is the largest university music camp in America and will enroll 1,800 students ages 10 to 18 (grade 5 through 12). For a complete description of the camp, please refer to a music camp brochure or refer to our website www.smcamp.org.

Duties of Camp Counselors: All counselors will live in the dorm and chaperone a floor (or half a floor). Other duties will be assigned based on camp need in the following areas: attendance taking at rehearsal, errands of all types, sectional rehearsals, performing in an instrumental or vocal ensemble, accompanying, assisting with Musicianship class or other classes, general supervision of students, etc.

Time Requirements for Counselors 2010:

Week 1: Saturday, July 10 at 6 p.m. thru Friday, July 16 (10 p.m.) and
Week 2: Saturday, July 17 at 6 p.m. thru Friday, July 23 (10 p.m.)

You will be busy all day every day! It is not possible to attend Summer School at the same time.

Salary:	\$300.00 salary per week of camp for counselors
